Thank you for your reply of 16 December. I am surprised and extremely disappointed by your response. It seems you are clearly out of touch with the anger felt amongst ordinary people on this issue.

Instead of answering my questions, you attempted to create a diversion of disputing the fact that you published your blacked-out receipts only after I had called on you to do so. This is evidenced by my original press release which was issued on 18th May 2009, while a check of your website today will show you only undertook to publish your receipts online that same day. You didn't actually publish any receipts till later that month, while other MPs had done so immediately when they were given them the month prior.

You were slow to judge the public mood then, and it appears progress has still not been made. I would like to give you another opportunity to answer my sixteen questions.

I also have an additional query. In the 2004/05 year, which I accessed on the UK Parliament website as you chose not to place that year on your website, your mortgage payments were £1,180 per month. It appears you changed your London home since then to the one you are claiming £2,000 per month for now. Why was there a need for something more expensive?
